# DIRECTIONS TO THE NASSAU BOCES ROBERT E. LUPINSKIE CENTER

1 Merrick Avenue • Merrick, NY 11590

\*Note: You can't turn left when exiting the Merrick Avenue driveway.

### Directions from the East:

- Northern State Parkway West.
- Take exit 32 toward Westbury.
- · Turn left at Post Avenue.
- Post Avenue turns into Merrick Avenue.
- Continue south on Merrick Avenue.

The Center will be on the right.

### **Directions from the South:**

- Meadowbrook Parkway North to Exit M1.
- Take Old Country Road East.
- Turn Right on Merrick Avenue going south.
- OR Wantagh Parkway North to Exit W2.
- Take Old Country Road West.
- Turn left on Merrick Avenue heading south.

The Center will be on the right.

### Directions from the West:

- Long Island Expressway/ I-495 East.
- Take exit 38 for Northern State Parkway toward Hauppauge.
- Merge onto Northern State Parkway East.
- Take exit 31A for Meadowbrook Parkway.
- Merge onto Meadowbrook State Parkway South to Exit M1E.
- · Take Old Country Road East.
- Turn Right on Merrick Avenue going south.

The Center will be on the right.

### **Directions from the North:**

- Meadowbrook Parkway South to Exit M1E.
- Take Old Country Road East.
- Turn Right on Merrick Avenue and continue south.
- OR Wantagh Parkway South to Exit W2.
- Take Old Country Road West.
- Turn left to Merrick Avenue heading south.
